**14. STARTING ORDER**

**Drifting** - The starting order will be determined after qualifying runs have been completed. Top 32/16 will compete tandem runs as per the ladder.

**15. DRIVERS BRIEFING**

The starting instructions will be given at this briefing. It is compulsory for all competitors, Marshal's and other officials to attend the briefing.

**15.A. VEHICLES**

**16. ADVERTISING**

Competitors' attention is drawn to GCR 246(iii), which makes it a condition of entry to display sponsors' advertising material supplied by the Organizers. Refer also to GCR 247.

**17. ACQUAINTANCE WITH AND SUBMISSION TO THE RULES**

Competitors' attention is drawn to GCR 122.

**18. CHANGE OF VEHICLE OR BIKE**

The Clerk of the Course has the option of allowing a driver to change cars but only under the following conditions:

- Changes must be made before the qualifying round.
- The driver must have entered and scrutineered the additional vehicle as per the event regulations.
- The vehicle must be in the same class/bracket as the one that is replaced.

No changes will be permitted after qualifying has been completed.

## **19. EVENT HEADQUARTERS AND NOTICE BOARD**

### Event Headquarters

Event Headquarters and the Official Notice Board will be situated at:

**Competitors are requested to read the Final Instructions posted on the official notice board before the event. Further, competitors are requested to check the notice board periodically.**

## **20. PASSENGERS**

### DRIFTING

A passenger may be carried in a Drift vehicle subject to the following conditions:

- Approval shall be at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course (CoC).
- The vehicle must be of a sedan/bakkie type nature.
- The passenger must sign a form indemnifying the respective track organizer/s and MSA from any misfortune.
- The passenger must be afforded the same measure of protection as is afforded the driver ie. Long sleeves and long pants.

A passenger may only be carried in a Drift vehicle **during practice** – **NO PASSENGER WILL BE ALLOWED DURING OFFICIAL PRACTICE / QUALIFYING AND COMPETITION.**

## **21. DRIVING CONDUCT**

The Clerk of the Course may exclude or impose a fine on any competitor for:

- Driving excessively fast exiting the pit lanes (including crew vehicles).
- Static burnouts on the tarmac.
- Failing to report to register in respect of the vehicle breakdown before the start of main race.
- Hooliganism and any profanity.
- Failure to attend the compulsory driver briefings.
- Driver/Crew leaving car/unattended in the pit lanes.
- Depositing foreign matter including debris or oil onto strip or staging lanes, except in the case where an accident has occurred.
- Unsportsmanship behaviour.
- Being suspected or seen to be consuming alcohol, regardless of the amount, before or during the event.
- Disregarding a specific instruction from an official.
- Contravening any infringement stipulated in the 2020 MSA SupaDrift Championship SSRs.
- Behaving in a manner, which could prejudice MSA and the Organiser.

## **22. RESULTS**

- Subject to no protests being received in terms of GCR 200, the **results will become final immediately on Saturday 8<sup>th</sup> Jun 2019**
- Competitors' attention is drawn to Parts IX and X and Appendix "R" of the MSA Handbook for protests and appeals.

## **23. PROTESTS AND APPEALS**

All protests and appeals will be dealt with as set out in GCR Appendix R, Parts IX and X.

## **24. AWARDS**

All awards will be distributed at Prize giving.

- Drifting - Trophies will be awarded to the drivers placed first, second, and third overall. 1 X Trophy will be awarded for the Driver of the Day.

## **25. RIGHTS OF THE CLERK OF THE COURSE - PROMOTERS AND ORGANIZERS**

The Promoters/Organizers reserve the right (subject to the approval of MSA) to:

- Postpone, abandon or cancel the event for reasons of force majeure (Refer to GCR's 62 and 244) In the event of postponement for more than 24 hours, entrants will be refunded their entry fee. Refer to GCR 109(iv);
- Postpone abandon or cancel the event if fewer than ten paid entries are received by the time and date of entries closing. Refer to GCR 99(v);
- Refuse any entry. Refer to GCR's 99(i) and 100.
